Around The Traps ...

Well March has certainly been an extremely full-on Month with both the **2009 Canberra Royal** and 1 week later the running of the **2nd Border Collie National**, also held in Canberra ACT taking place. Canberra Royal results can be seen later in this edition. A full run down of the National will be produced once all information is at hand but a general “flavour” of the event is detailed below.

The National attracted an incredible entry of 822 across all disciplines including a breed entry of 332 no doubt the biggest entry of BCs of all time (in Aust) and almost all major kennels as well as a lot of the smaller kennels were represented. UK Breed Specialists Ross and Vicky Green (Fayken BCs) were the judges for this event and after 2 exhaustive days of showing and judging and many nail biting decisions, the major breed winners were decided as follows:

BEST IN SHOW/CHALLENGE DOG:	Ch. Innisman All Said N Done (Hall)
R/UP BEST IN SHOW/CHALLENGE BITCH:	Ch. Danari Datewith Destiny (Wheatley)
RESERVE CHALLENGE DOG:	Ch. Glentress Ostentatious (Adams)
RESERVE CHALLENGE BITCH:	Ch Majalibre Great Calamity (Bailey)

As most would appreciate, the National isn't just about showing or trialling but the appeal of this unique event is the social side and the chance to catch up with country and interstate friends and to simply “talk dogs”. The fact that it comes around only every 3 years (much like the Olympics really!) also seems to guarantee a huge entry with the chance to compete against all comers and the very best just too much of a temptation for most of us to resist.

It also provides a brilliant opportunity to see the depth of quality coming through and to see what certain dogs are producing. The younger classes again proved popular and a lot of kennels took the opportunity to bring out younger stock with baby, minor, puppy and junior classes well supported. Of course, the intermediate, australian bred and open classes were huge with an incredible 46 entered in the Aust Bred Bitch class – I think it took close to 2 hours to judge that class alone

The National again proved popular with overseas BC enthusiasts with visitors from the US, UK, Japan and NZ to name a few and most seemed to agree that the quality in Australia continues to be up there with the very best interestingly, the judges also commented to this effect at the presentation dinner. Speaking of the judges, both Ross and Vicky Green appeared to enjoy their appointments hugely but I'll leave it to their critiques to communicate their true thoughts on our dogs.

On a final note, congratulations to the committee of the NSW Southern Districts Country Border Collie Club, for the successful hosting of the 2nd National, pulling a National together is no mean feat especially when expectations are high, its impossible to please everybody but no one could doubt their commitment, at the end of the day you can only do your best.

The 3rd National will be hosted by the BCC of Tasmania which in itself will be very interesting. No doubt the venue will be spectacular with it's sheer natural beauty but getting exhibitors and more importantly their dogs to Tassie will pose a real challenge Stay tuned for that one !!
