It is with a very heavy heart that we write of the passing of two Border Collie Greats of the past 12-14 years, Gr Ch. Tullacrest Soul Mate "Sol" and his half brother, Ch. Tullacrest Thiefa Hearts "Charlie".

All of a sudden on the 19<sup>th</sup> January this year our gorgeous boy, "Sol", ex Gr.Ch. Khayoz Soul Deep and Ch. Tullacrest Lovem-n-Levem, passed away at the age of 12 years. He was aptly named and was truly my shadow. From the age of two weeks when he used to sit on my lap driving to the vets every other day for special eye drops to be inserted into an eye that had to be stitched shut to allow an injury caused by his mum stepping on him in error, the bond was set. As a young boy, he had a wicked sense of humour and would drive us to distraction trying to get him to run in straight lines of a triangle. Half way along the first leg of his triangle, he decided he would left turn, no way was he going the full length of the triangle and he soon learnt if he rushed around the ring at a million miles an hour to get to the end, he would get a treat from "mum".....yummy..... It took a while for him to learn to do it the right way and eventually the penny dropped as to what was expected of him. He went onto win multiple Best in Groups, Best in Show All Breeds and Specialties throughout his illustrious career. He was a Puppy in Group Melbourne Royal winner, a Best in Group and Third Best in Show Melbourne Royal Winner. He was twice top dog All Breeds for South Australia and represented the State at the Australasian Show Dog Final of the Year Competition. Not only was he a great show dog, but has sired many beautiful and successful progeny over all disciplines. We are truly proud of what he has added to the Border Collie gene pool now and for many generations to come.

Already a very sad start to our 2009, we also said good bye to "Charlie", ex Ch. & NZ Ch. Loch-n-Legacy to Clan-Abby and Ch. Tullacrest Lovem-n-Levem, on the 27<sup>th</sup> May. "Charlie" titled quickly and did very well in the showring, but didn't really enjoy it. The opportunity arose for him to live in one of the very best of pet homes, so off he went to live with very good friends as their much loved companion. He had many admirers in the street where he lived and each day people would stop, give him a pat through the front gate and have a chat. His owners were amazed at how he drew people in. His temperament was so easy going, steady and all that met him, soon became very attached. He was used quite extensively at stud throughout his lifetime, producing many outstanding progeny, 3 grand champions and many Australian Champions. Another very special boy who has contributed to the Breed immensely.

We thank all those people who have written, emailed and phoned us about our two gorgeous boys. We would also like to thank all those people who have used and promoted their progeny and are doing so well with them. It is truly appreciated and we are so proud to have had these two boys in our lives.
