

Meet Your Committee...

Patrice Smith – Publicity Officer

I have been involved with Border Collies since the end of 1974, when I purchased a show puppy called Crestvale Gay Serena. I started breeding in 1976 under the Tullaview prefix, keeping the only dog puppy, Tullaview Tornado (Trouble) and from then on, the breed has been in my heart. I hail from Victoria, but please do not hold that against me, and moved to New South Wales in 1992, due to work. While I work full time in a management position in an IT company, a few months ago, I felt that I wanted to participate again in the evolution of the Border and 'have a say', hence putting up my hand to be an active member of the club.

I was born into the dog world, with my parents active in showing and breeding Border Collies and Shetland Sheepdogs. Moving to NSW when I was five, meant that while always having dogs in the yard, my showing experience was minimal until I was 14, when I asked to Mum to breed a sheltie litter so I could show them.
