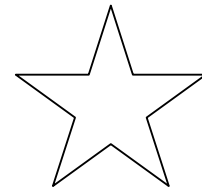

AROUND THE TRAPS

September and October are usually extremely hectic months on the BC calendar with a degree of stamina and a full tank of petrol (or airline tickets!) required to take advantage of the many major shows on offer, and so this year is no different with a number of Royals and Specialties taking place over the course of roughly an 8 week period, throughout Australia. Kicking off with **Adelaide Royal** on 12th September with NSW judge Mr M Le Cussen in charge of the breed. The day was a success for Benshiva Kennels winning the Dog Challenge and BOB with Gr Ch Benshiva Dot Com who went on to achieve Runner Up Best in Group and also taking Bitch Challenge and RUBOB with Ch. Nahrof Collectors Item. Reserve Dog was awarded to the SA exhibit Ch. Innisman All Said N Done (Hall) and Reserve Bitch to Sharon Hannigan's Ch. Neecabe Murrans Love.

The **Border Collie Club of Tasmania** held their championship show on Sunday 14th September with NSW Breed Specialist Mr Wayne Nicholls (Monochrome) presiding. Best In Show went to the Challenge Dog winner, Ch Sanpasho Xceed N Xcel HT(French). RUBIS was awarded to the Challenge Bitch winner, Glenloy Nite Moves (Jones) with the Reserve Dog and Bitch being awarded to Auldbrig Hellofaplapacetob HT (Jones) and Ch Gremaric Natural Grace (Pearcey) respectively.

Only 1 week later 2 more "majors" took place with both Melbourne Royal and the BCC of Qld Specialty taking place on the 20th September. **Melbourne Royal** judged by Mr I Awashima (Japan) saw a clean sweep for Glentress Kennels winning Challenge Dog/RUBOB with Ch Yeoville Epic Journey, Challenge Bitch/BOB with Ch Glentress Anastasia and the Reserve Dog and Bitch awards with Gr Ch. Glentress King O Theroad and Ch Glentress I Can Coz I Am. The Puppy of Breed was awarded to locals Maghera Kennels with Maghera Accidental Hero.

The **BCC of Qld Championship Show** was judged by NSW Breed Specialist Ms Lauren Somers (Nahrof) who chose Ch. Mylawn Make a Fortune (Smith) as her Challenge Dog and Best in Show winner. RUBIS went to the Reserve Dog, Richen's Ch. Gremaric Cruzin. Challenge Bitch was awarded to Ch. Trucharm The Power O Three (Leslie) and Reserve Bitch to Ch/Jap Ch Dazzling Bluestar JP A Dreamy Girl (Richens).

Back to NSW, and the weekend of 27/28 September saw next year's National hosts, **NSW Southern Districts BC Club** hold their annual double championship show. Saturday was judged by NSW Breed Specialist Ms Lorraine Warren-Powell who awarded Best in Show to the Dog Challenge winner, Gr Ch Benshiva Dot Com (Farrell) and RUBIS to the Bitch Challenge winner Ch. Danari Datewith Destiny (Wheatley). Reserve Dog went to Danari De Beers (Wheatley) and Reserve Bitch to Teresa Bailey's Ch. Tehya Destiny Allover. Sunday was judged by Mr J Maxwell (NSW) who awarded Best in Show and Challenge Bitch to the youngster, Nahrof Word Games (Somers/Bador), RUBIS went to the Reserve Bitch Ch Nahrof Collectors Item (Farrell/Somers/Bador) with Challenge Dog Ch Syryne Altair O Aqlae (Fossey) and Reserve Dog also to Nahrof Knls with Gr Ch Nahrof More Than Words.

Finally for this month, **Perth Royal** was this year judged by Snr Luiz Fernando Ribas Silva (Brazil) who awarded Best of Breed and State Bred in Group to the Challenge Dog winner, the well performed Grd Ch. Borderfame Mr Magic (Borderfame Knls). Borderfame dominated also taking out Challenge Bitch and RUBOB with Ch. Borderfame Moon Dancer as well as Reserve Dog with Grd/Am/Lux/Dutch Pol/ UKShCh Borderfame Heart N Soul. Reserve Bitch went to R Evans with Winpara Dark Desire.

Full results of all of the above events can be seen in this edition. I will be back with a full report, photos, critiques etc when they come to hand from the club's 56th championship show and trials, the last major specialty for the year and now its definitely time to catch our breath and prepare for 2009! Also next month a catch up of new champions, I know there are some who have achieved this milestone recently and you haven't been forgotten !

Well done to all who have enjoyed success at these and other events recently. Ed.

Shadow cast over hearts of McLaren Vale wine industry

SOUTH Australia's wine world lost a faithful friend this week with the death of Fox Creek winery mascot, Shadow.

Shadow, a border collie, greeted visitors to the McLaren Vale winery for more than a decade, appeared on TV shows and even had wine named after him.

Shadow's Run was released in 2001, a red wine named after the dog's habit of chasing trellis wire during vine pruning. A white wine followed.

Shadow was keen to help those on the land – a percentage of funds from the sale of that wine were donated to the farmers' drought appeal. "Shadow was loved by many people," said Fox Creek marketing manager Kristin McLarty, daughter of Shadow's owners Helen and Jim Watts.

"I always called Shadow our silent salesman, as he charmed many. He was the perfect host and would often meet and greet guests at the cellar door."

Shadow, who died on Tuesday, was brought from the local vet by Helen Watts 10 years ago. The puppy was unclaimed and was to have been put down.
